



## **ERASMUS FINANCIAL GRANTS - Internships**

Students-interns receive a combination of an EU Erasmus+ basic grant for particular country and 150 Eur top-up for traineeships, and Latvian state budget co-financing as contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during the confirmed period of physical mobility for Erasmus internship.

Students with **fewer opportunities**, with signed Declaration of Honour and supporting documents may receive <u>additional funding</u> up to **250 EUR** per month from the EU Erasmus+ funding. Documents submitted by student will be assessed and approved by RGSL.

"Green travel" support - additional funding 50 EUR total plus up to 4 extra days of finances for individual support if mode of travel to and from host country will be by train, bus, shared (with mobility students) car in both directions.

**Payments** are made in 2-3 parts based on special Erasmus financial grant agreement that is signed by RGSL and the Trainee before "physical" mobility:

- ✓ advance payment made 1-3 weeks before travel for the first 3 months or, if shorter total mobility duration - 90% of the total grant applicable to the entire internship period;
- ✓ Final payment after internship is completed and Certificate of Completed Traineeship is submitted to RGSL as well as Erasmus+ final report (online EU feedback questionnaire).
