



ERASMUS FINANCIAL GRANTS - Internships

Students receive a combination of an **EU grant + traineeship top-up + Latvian state budget co-financing** as contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during **the official period of Erasmus internship abroad**.

Group 1 Programme Countries with higher living costs	Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Ireland, Luxembourg, Sweden, Liechtenstein, Norway	520 EUR + 100 EUR top-up + 100 EUR
Group 2 Programme Countries with medium living costs	Austria, Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, Netherlands, Malta, Portugal	470 EUR + 100 EUR top-up + 100 EUR
Group 3 Programme Countries with lower living costs	Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Lithuania, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey	420 EUR + 100 EUR top-up + 100 EUR

NB! Additional funding: students from low-income, disadvantaged background (certified by authorities such as social services or other) may receive additional funding up to EUR 100 per month from the EU funding.

Payments are usually made in 2 parts (for shorter internships) or 3 parts (for longer duration traineeships) based on Erasmus financial grant agreement that is signed by RGSL and the Trainee (graduate) before “physical” mobility:

- ✓ advance payment (1-3 weeks before travel) for the minimum period 3 months or 90% of the total financing amount;
- ✓ final payment after the trainee has completed work placement and submitted Erasmus final reports (*online EU feedback questionnaire, has submitted to RGSL experience story and Certificate of Completed Traineeship signed by Host institution*).
