

## ERASMUS FINANCIAL GRANTS - STUDIES

Students receive a combination of an EU Erasmus+ grant *plus* Latvian state budget co-financing as contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during the confirmed period of **physical mobility for Erasmus studies**.

Students with **fewer opportunities**, from low-income, disadvantaged background (certified by authorities such as social services or other) may receive additional funding up to EUR 250 per month from the EU Erasmus+ funding.

**Payments** are made in 2 parts based on special Erasmus financial grant agreement that is signed by RGSL and the Student before “physical” mobility:

- ✓ advance payment made 1-3 weeks before travel - 90% of the total financial amount for the entire study semester;
- ✓ final payment after student has completed mobility and submitted Erasmus final reports (*online EU feedback questionnaire, has submitted to RGSL experience story and start-end dates of mobility period Certificate signed by partner university*).
