



Call for Applications for ERASMUS+ student mobility grants for studies at partner university in the **Autumn semester 2026**

Erasmus studies **in the Autumn** semester are open to:

- Masters students in the two-year study programme,
- Bachelor students who **will be in Year 3** during autumn exchange semester.

Application deadline: **2 March 10:00 AM**

General requirements

- Students must obtain **27 ECTS** during exchange semester (preferably 30 ECTS). *Note that Receiving partner universities may have a requirement of 30 ECTS full workload, then student must follow this.*
- **All courses successfully completed** at the partner university, based on issued official Grade Transcript, will be transferred through process of **automatic academic recognition** and will substitute RGSL courses.
- Majority study subjects at partner university must be **law courses** corresponding as closely as possible to student's core programme at RGSL. Partner agreements are generally with Law Faculties.
- In addition, students are encouraged to choose also foreign **language course** - it will be recognized in C part at RGSL within the permitted limit of 9 ECTS during bachelor curriculum, or as an additional course in student's diploma supplement.

Selection criteria:

1. Good academic performance with **grade average** 6.5 or higher (in LAIS) of all graded courses at RGSL taken up to the date of application deadline (the actual average grade points will be used in total score evaluation, for example, 7.3)
2. **Motivation statement** inside online application (max 400 words) (up to 3 points)
3. Recent (since August 2025) participation in student activities **supported by written, signed reference letter** to be submitted before the deadline in email to Erasmus coordinator ulla@rgsl.edu.lv¹ (up to 3 points)
4. **Priority** will be given to students with *fewer opportunities*.
5. In case of competing applications **priority** will be given to students for whom this **semester-long** Erasmus+ mobility will be for the first-time.
6. **Application will not be considered** if student has **financial or academic debt** at RGSL (missing payments of tuition fees, missing credits in mandatory A part courses and end-year research papers; disciplinary sanctions within the past 6 months). Exceptionally one B part elective course debt may be accepted (if justified and re-exam is being planned, must be explained in the application's final section 'Open space for additional remarks').

¹ For example, representing RGSL in Moot Court, active member of Student Association, active Buddy for Erasmus incoming student; having represented RGSL in conferences.

Choice of partner university: refer to the list of [Partner Universities for Autumn 2026](#)

Financial grant amounts: refer to the table of [Funding grants project 2025](#). Students receive a one-time travel support, and monthly EU funding + Latvian State co-funding, according to set groups of countries and available project funds at RGSL.

Additional funding 250 EUR per month may be granted to students ***with fewer opportunities*** to support their chance of going on mobility (for example, if student has a disability, social or economic barriers -disadvantaged background, student has a refugee status in Latvia, active *Godā Gimenes karte*). If applicable, student will need to submit, before going on Erasmus+ mobility, supporting documents about their condition and status.

“Green travel” support - additional funding: if mode of travel to and from host country majority of distance in both directions will be by train, bus, shared car (shared with another mobility participant), student will receive a slightly higher financial support for travel and extra days of individual support, if extra travel time needed for “green travel” mode.

Selection results: RGSL Selection Committee will take a decision and results will be communicated to students individually within 2 weeks after the application deadline.
