



Call for Applications for ERASMUS+ student mobility grants for studies at partner university in the **Spring semester 2026**

Erasmus studies in Spring semester are open only to **Year 2** Bachelor students.

Earlier deadline: 10 September 12:00 noon for applications to Maastricht University and UniCatolica Milan
Regular deadline: 16 September 12:00 noon to all other listed partners

General requirements

- Students will have to obtain in general the minimum **27 ECTS** during exchange semester (preferably 30 ECTS). *Note that Receiving partner universities may have a requirement of 30 ECTS full workload, then student must follow this.*
- **Exception** is Leibniz University Hannover: due to late 2nd semester starting date 1 April, RGSL students finish Module 4 at RGSL, and then go for exchange studies to Hannover and may choose ~18~21 ECTS minimum study load.
- Majority study subjects at partner university must be **law courses** corresponding as closely as possible to student's core programme LB or LD at RGSL. Partner agreements are generally with Law Faculties.
- In addition, students are encouraged to choose also foreign **language course**- (it will be recognized in C part at RGSL within the permitted limit of 9 ECTS during bachelor study curriculum, or as an additional course in student's diploma supplement.
- All courses successfully completed at the partner university will be transferred through process of **automatic academic recognition** and will substitute RGSL courses.

Selection criteria:

1. Good academic performance with **grade average** 7 or higher of all graded courses at RGSL taken up to the date of deadline: **60%**
2. **Motivation statement** inside online application (max 400 words) **20%**
3. Recent (past 6-7 months) **RGSL-related "extra" activity** confirmed by written signed official **reference letter** (to submit in email before the deadline to Erasmus coordinator)¹ **20%**
4. No financial or academic debt at RGSL (no missing payments of tuition fees, no missing ECTS, including end-year research papers). No disciplinary sanctions within the past 6 months.

¹ For example, representing RGSL in Moot Court, active member of Student Association, active Buddy for Erasmus incoming student; having represented RGSL in promotion campaigns, exhibitions, or conferences.

5. In case of competing applications priority will be given to students for whom this Erasmus+ mobility will be the first-time mobility (counting Erasmus and Nordplus summer schools and alike).

Choice of partner university: refer [to the updated list of Partners for Spring 2026](#).

Financial grant amounts: refer to the table of [Funding grants project 2025](#). Students receive a one-time travel support, and monthly EU funding + Latvian State co-funding, according to set groups of countries and available project funds at RGSL.

Additional funding 250 EUR per month may be granted to students [with fewer opportunities](#) to support their chance of going on mobility (for example, if student has a disability, or serious medical condition, social or economic barriers, disadvantaged background, or if student has a refugee status in Latvia, or have an active *Goda Ģimenes karte*). If applicable, student will need to submit, before going on Erasmus+ mobility, supporting documents about their condition and status.

“Green travel” support - additional funding: if mode of travel to and from host country will be by train, bus, shared car in both directions (shared with another mobility participant), student will receive a slightly higher financial support for travel and extra days of individual support, if extra travel time needed for “green travel” mode.

Selection results: RGSL Selection Committee will take a decision and results will be communicated to students individually within a week after the application deadline (for Maastricht and UniCatolica Milan within 3 days).
