



ACTION IN THE EVENT OF A TERRORIST ATTACK

1. PAY ATTENTION TO SUSPICIOUS PERSONS, BAGS OR PACKAGES

- Stay alert to suspicious behaviour, unattended objects or unusual situations
- Immediately report suspicious activity to security personnel or responsible staff



2. DO NOT APPROACH OR TOUCH SUSPICIOUS OBJECTS

- Do not touch suspicious objects
- Do not move, open or inspect them
- Move away from the area



3. IF YOU NOTICE A SUSPICIOUS OBJECT, LEAVE THE AREA AND INFORM STAFF

- Leave the area immediately
- Inform security staff, building personnel or responsible persons



4. IMMEDIATELY CONTACT EMERGENCY SERVICES — CALL 112

Report:

- what happened;
- where it happened;
- potential threats;
- number of people involved;
- other important details



IF THE ATTACK IS ONGOING

5. RUN AND FOLLOW EVACUATION INSTRUCTIONS

- If possible, immediately escape from the danger area
- Use the nearest safe evacuation route
- Help others only if it does not endanger your own safety



6. IF ESCAPE IS IMPOSSIBLE — HIDE

- Find a secure hiding place out of the attacker's view
- Lock or barricade doors if possible
- Stay quiet



7. SILENCE DEVICES WHILE HIDING

- Turn off lights, phone sounds and vibration
- Switch off other devices that may create noise



8. ONCE SAFE — REPORT THE INCIDENT

- Once safe, contact emergency services or call 112
- Provide accurate information about the situation



9. DO NOT CONFRONT THE ATTACKER

- Do not attempt to stop the attacker unless absolutely necessary to save a life
- Survival and reaching safety are the priority



10. WHEN POLICE ARRIVES

- Avoid sudden movements, keep your hands visible.
- Provide requested information, follow police instructions immediately
