

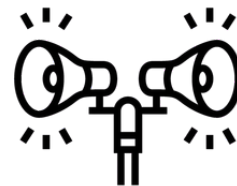


ACTION IN THE EVENT OF NATURAL DISASTERS AND EXTERNAL TECHNOLOGICAL EMERGENCIES



1. CITY EMERGENCY SIRENS ARE ACTIVATED

- In the event of disaster threats, civil protection warning sirens may be activated
- Sirens indicate potential danger and the need to follow further instructions



2. BUILDING ALARMS ARE ACTIVATED AND INSTRUCTIONS ARE PROVIDED

- RGSL staff, students and visitors may receive warnings through alarms or voice announcements
- Follow instructions provided and remain calm



3. RECEIVE INFORMATION ABOUT REQUIRED ACTIONS

- Follow information regarding required actions during emergency
- Use official information channels or civil protection applications (e.g., 112 Latvia)
- Turn on radio, television or official applications;
- Listen to announcements regarding the event and safety measures;
- Keep information sources active until further instructions are received



IN CASE OF STORM OR EXTREME WEATHER

- Avoid going outdoors unless absolutely necessary
- Stay away from windows, trees and unstable structures
- Remain in a safe place until conditions improve



IN CASE OF RADIOACTIVE CONTAMINATION

- Stay inside sealed or enclosed spaces
- Avoid outdoor exposure
- Take iodine tablets only when instructed by medical personnel or authorities



MAIN PRINCIPLE: DURING DISASTERS, THE PRIORITY IS TO FOLLOW OFFICIAL WARNINGS, REMAIN CALM AND COMPLY WITH INSTRUCTIONS.
